

## FLAGS

Flag	COLOR	MEANING	WHAT TO DO
	Green	Start	Track is hot! This also signals the start of your session.
	Yellow	Caution	Car spinout or in line of danger / proceed with caution until yellow is not displayed or green flag is displayed.
	Red	Accident	Stop as quickly and cautiously as possible, watch for oncoming cars from behind, then pull over to the side and wait for further instructions from corner marshals.
	Black	Penalty	Come in to pit-lane to discuss penalty/incident and receive further instructions from track staff or steward.
	Blue	Passing	Let the car behind pass per event rules. Hand signals indicating which side to pass on are always preferred.
	White	Last Lap	One Lap to go before Checkered Flag.
	Red-Yellow	Debris	Debris on the track (rocks, dirt, oil, coolant etc.)
	Meatball	Mechanical	Come into pits. You probably have a mechanical problem with your car.
	Checkered	Finish	End of session, reduce speed, complete lap, and come into pit-lane

\*Every track has different set of rules. The above are guidelines and could vary.
